SHED PROGRESS

The good news is that this week we have engaged Fair Dinkum Sheds to supply our shed. This means that we can now complete the process leading up to Building Approval. When this is received we can engage contractors to finish clearing the site, prepare the site and construct a slab for our building. We are looking at commencing work before Christmas with completion in the New Year.

WORK TO BE DONE

Before any work can commence on our construction we need to do the following:

1. Finish removing, splitting and stacking logs from the site.
2. Move previously stacked wood which is within the bushfire hazard area.
3. Clear vegetation from the area which will become our car park.

WORKING BEE

This will be held this Saturday, 5th. November at 2972 South Arm Road, South Arm at anytime from 9.00 am. People with mattocks to clear vegetation are needed in addition to splitters and stackers.

Anyone unable to attend on Saturday and would prefer Friday, please let me know and I'll arrange for someone to keep you company.

If we get a good roll up we should complete the work and be able to take a break until the construction phase when Eric has some work lined up for us.
